Professor Achim Kampker was born in Moers on January 2nd, 1976. He studied mechanical engineering with a focus on production engineering at RWTH Aachen University and is the founder and holder of today's RWTH Chair of “Production Engineering of E-Mobility Components”. In eight research groups, he and his team are dedicated to the production, development and recycling of battery systems and their components as well as fuel cells, the production of the electric drive train and entire vehicle concepts. Kampker co-developed the “StreetScooter” electric vehicle in Aachen and was managing director of StreetScooter GmbH from December 2014 to April 2019. In addition to teaching at RWTH Aachen University, he acts as member of the executive board of the “Fraunhofer Research Institution for Battery Cell Production FFB” in Münster, Germany. Kampker also devotes himself to numerous projects. These include his commitment to the sustainability model city “Humanotop” as well as his involvement in the “Expert Group Transformation of the Automotive Industry” (ETA) of the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK) and in the “Expert Council on Electric Mobility” of the state government of North Rhine-Westphalia.
